Maths

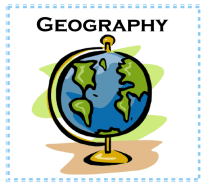
This term we will be focusing on:

History

In **history** we will continue studying

struggle for the Kingdom of
England.



Computing

In Computing, we will be creating a
short television advert. The pupils
will also be reviewing existing
adverts and promotional videos to
help them generate ideas for their
own video.



RE

This half term our topic is ' Sacred
Texts'. We will understand what it
means to belong to a religion. We
will research the holy books of
Christianity and Islam, The Bible
and Qur'an and we will discuss
similarities and differences between
the two.

PSHE

Our Values focus this half term is
Anti-Bullying

We will begin by identifying our
feeling and emotions and reflect on
how we can cope with the feelings
of anxiety and anger.

Next, we will learn about different
types of bullying and we will discuss
the way we treat others and how to
resolve conflict safely and maturely.

Design & Technology

We will be investigating different materials and finding out what purposes they fulfil.

Science

In **science**, will continue to explore Energy and Sound and we will prepare even more fascinating experiments!

Art

We will continue to find out about our class artists whilst also making a 3D sculptures based on our Viking topic.



PE

PE will take place on **Wednesdays and Fridays**. It is essential that your child has the correct school PE uniform for each session.

They will be developing their football skills paying particular attention to improving their technique. This will then be implemented during match play. They will go through circuit and endurance activities which include strength and power exercises.

Music
