Dear Parents, Carers, Children and Staff,

Bringing Food in to School

Please remember that Campsbourne, like most schools, does not allow any products containing nuts in the school. This is because there are a number of children in school who are allergic to them. Nut allergies are very serious and a reaction can potentially be fatal. This ban includes all nut products, such as peanut butter and Nutella, and includes anything containing groundnut oil. Packed Lunches

As an accredited National Healthy School, we are committed to promote and monitor healthy lifestyles. Please remember that the following items are not allowed in your child's packed lunch: fizzy drinks and sweets – including chocolate.

Clothing

Uniform is compulsory for all the children currently in reception and years 1, 2 and 3. Please ensure your child wears a top with a Campsbourne logo and dark coloured trousers or skirt. ALL CHILDREN should wear sensible footwear. For safety reasons children are not allowed to wear jewellery, apart from studs or sleepers. Please ensure all items of clothing are clearly labelled with your child's name!

It is important that parents wait behind the white line, so the class teacher can safely hand over the pupils to their appropriate adult at home time.
