Important Information: Alexandra Park Closure

Alexandra Palace Fireworks Festival 2017 takes place on Friday 3rd and Saturday 4th November. The park will be fully closed from 8pm on Thursday 3rd until 7am Sunday 5th November, this includes all gates and Alexandra Palace Way. The W3 bus will also be diverted. For those who walk to school from Alexandra Palace Station through the park to the Newland Road gate, wristbands are now available from the school office to allow access on Friday 3rd November morning only. Due to the event build, wristbands will only allow access from Alexandra Palace Station, not from any other park gate. Due to event security, we are afraid no access will be available after 12pm.
