Accelerated Reader

The Accelerated Reader Program has had a great start with over 120 children taking quizzes and achieving 85% or more. All these children have received certificates today and I know we are not far off from awarding our first book for a child to choose for their own library at home as a result of achieving 85% or more in six quizzes. I wonder who will be the first? On Thursday 23rd March at 9am and 4.45pm we will be running a workshop for parents who have children in years 2 to 6 to explain Accelerated Reader and how they can login to the parent portal.

Whilst I'm pleased to say that our attendance is good I'm afraid our punctuality is appalling. So far this academic year we have 1281 late marks which is unacceptably high. The bell rings at 8.50 in the infant school at 8.55 in the junior school with school starting 5 mins later. Please can you make sure that your child arrives to school on time every day!
