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NEXT WEEK ACTIVITIES FOR CAMPSBOURNE!

Week Beginning: 07/12/15

Reception	<p>Next week we will be focusing on the celebration of 'Christmas'. In preparation for our Christmas show, in arts and design we will be making some props/hats for our staging/outfits. We will be making Christmas cards and on writing day we will be writing a message inside them for a friend or family member. We will also be cooking mince pies, so any donations towards ingredients would be great! Our Christmas show takes place on the 16th of December at 9.30am. Could your child please bring in an outfit (RED clothing for children in class Mondrian and GREEN clothing for children in class Matisse) in a plastic bag with their name on it please. Have a lovely weekend.</p>
Year 1	<p>Literacy – We will be reading some well-known children’s stories and using storyboards to retell them orally. The children will then use picture prompts to re-write one of the stories in their own words.</p> <p>Maths – To add a 2-digit number and a 1-digit number by regrouping ten. To subtract by taking away from the ones. To subtract by regrouping the ten.</p> <p>Art – Making Christmas decorations and cards.</p> <p>Costumes for the show: 1Riley and 1Brooks – The children will be angels so could you please send your child in with a white top and trousers or leggings and a piece of tinsel for their head. Can you please put all items in a labelled bag.</p>
Year 2	<p>Julie’s Language and Literacy group will be looking at playscripts. Christina’s Literacy and Language group will be writing their own explanation texts. RML will continue as usual. In Maths Mastery we continue to at look different types of graphs and use them to gather information. In Science we will be assessing the children’s knowledge of Living Things and their Habitats. In Computing children will be taking part in the ‘Hour of Coding’ week, the idea is that every pupil (across the world) does an hour of coding sometime during the week. Christmas cards will continue. Please check your child’s book bag for a letter about what we would like them to wear for the Christmas play. If there are any problems please let us know.</p>
Year 3	<p>Maths: The children will be focusing on different methods to add and subtract 3 digit and 4 digit numbers.</p> <p>Literacy: Children will revisit The Enchantress of the Sands (folk tale) and begin thinking about an alternative climax.</p> <p>PE: Please ensure your child has their PE kit in school on Wednesdays/Thursdays.</p> <p>***REMINDER: Year 3 will commence dress rehearsals for the Christmas Show on Monday, 7th December.</p> <p>Please ensure your child has brought in the following:</p> <p>Monet : plain green t-shirt/jumper and dark trousers/leggings</p> <p>Kandinsky: green, white, red or Christmas jumper/t-shirt and dark leggings/trousers(any spare Christmas cards would be appreciated!)</p>
Year 4	<p>Maths: This week we will be studying fractions of number.</p> <p>English: We will be looking at diary writing linked to Greek Myths and attempting some of our own.</p> <p>Topic: This will continue with Ancient Greece and the Trojan War.</p> <p>PE: Thursdays and Fridays for BOTH Classes. <u>Some children are still not bringing an appropriate change of kit for these lessons. Please ensure that PE kit is provided.</u> This is a health and safety requirement for all schools.</p> <p>Homework: This is the final homework for this term. Please encourage your child to complete homework and return it on Wednesdays. Reading daily with your child and discussing the text will aid their progress in all subjects. Handwriting and times tables also need to be practised for short bursts each day.</p> <p>TRUMPET & CLARINET RECITAL: Well done to all year 4 who took part with great flair. You must all be very proud parents!</p> <p>TRIP: Please ensure you have returned your slips for our theatre trip on Wednesday 9th. We will be returning to school later than usual at approximately 4.30pm. Please can you provide a snack for your child to eat at the theatre. We are still looking for helpers. Please let your class teacher know if you can accompany us.</p>
Year 5	<p>Maths: We will be working on division, prime numbers and establishing prime numbers up to 100.</p> <p>English: We will be writing a story from a character’s perspective.</p> <p>Science: We will be assessing the phases of the Moon and how and why it changes.</p> <p>Topic: We will be looking at Hornsey Town Hall and its influence in the local area.</p> <p>PE: Monday and Tuesday. On Monday, the children require both their swimming and PE kits. On Tuesday, the children just need their PE kits.</p> <p>Homework: Will be given on Monday, to be handed in on Friday.</p> <p>Trip: We are going on a trip to Park Theatre on Tuesday (8th). Any parent volunteers that are available to come, please let either Mr Mattocks or Miss L know as soon as possible.</p>
Year 6	<p>Maths - identifying common factors and common multiples as well as using the formal written method of short division.</p> <p>English - write a biography on a classmate.</p> <p>Topic - investigate crime and punishment from Anglo-Saxon Britain and understand how the legal system worked during this time.</p> <p>Science - end of unit test on evolution and inheritance.</p> <p>PE/Swimming will take place on a Friday afternoon. Please ensure your child brings the appropriate kit.</p>
