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NEXT WEEK ACTIVITIES FOR CAMPSBOURNE!

Week Beginning: 12/12/16

Nursery	<p>We had so much fun toasting marshmallows and sipping hot chocolate around our fire at Forest School last Thursday and next week we are reaching an exciting conclusion to our topic Colour and Light by getting ready for the festivals of Christmas and Hanukah. See you at the Christmas show at 9.30am on Friday and don't forget to get baking or shopping for our cake sale after school the same day.</p>
Reception	<p>Next week we will continue with the celebration of 'Christmas'. We will be making Christmas decorations and cards. A reminder please...that your child should bring in their outfit for the Christmas show in a plastic bag with their name on it. Mondrian-green top/jumper; Matisse-red top/jumper. The children can wear dark trousers/skirt or leggings. Letters have gone out for the show, please can you return the reply slip by Monday the 12th of December, thank you. Have a lovely weekend!</p>
Year 1	<p>Next week the children will continue with the celebrations and preparations needed for our Christmas show and classroom activities.</p> <p>We will also finish our kites and then evaluate our kite making skills.</p> <p>We will be looking back at our knowledge, understanding and skills in mathematics and Literacy. Then, we will reflect on what we were good at and our areas for improvement. We will set some personal goals for next term.</p> <p>The children will need to wear black and white for the Christmas show. Any combination will be fine. Please put their name on their clothing and the bag they are to bring in. The show is on Friday 16th December 2016 at 11:00am and then at 2.00pm.</p>
Year 2	<p>Maths: The children will be practising their recall of the 2, 5 and 10 multiplication tables. They will be solving word problems involving multiplication.</p> <p>Literacy: We will continue looking at our new "Rags to Riches" story, Cinderella. The children will be looking at the vocabulary and sentence types used by the author and they will be writing character descriptions for the main characters.</p> <p>D&T and Art: The children will continue to make their hand puppets. They will also be taking part in festive art activities.</p> <p>Christmas Concert: The children will be performing at 11am and 2pm on Friday 16th December. Please ensure they have their <u>costumes in school by Wednesday 14th December</u> at the latest. Thank you!</p>
Year 3	<p>Maths: Children will solve word problems involving length and then begin a new unit focusing on multiplication and division. We will investigate the relationship between \times and \div !</p> <p>Literacy: Children will continue to learn their new story through oral rehearsal and then familiarise themselves with the written text through reading and vocabulary work.</p> <p>Science: Next week, children will find patterns when investigating how shadows change size.</p> <p>Topic: Children will learn about hillforts and Stonehenge.</p> <p>PE: Please ensure children bring their PE kits weekly on Wednesdays and swimming kits fortnightly on Fridays. Please support your children with regular reading, spellings and times table practice.</p>
Year 4	<p>English –We will be working on improving our writing using a variety of grammatical features</p> <p>Maths –We will begin our multiplication revision module to ensure we have a deep understanding of this ready for fractions after the holidays.</p> <p>Science – We will looking at local habitat studies.</p> <p>P.E. - Both Picasso and Sekoto need to bring in their P.E kits on Friday.</p> <p>Swimming - Classes will swim on alternate Mondays, Sekoto will be swimming this Monday. PLEASE REMEMBER SWIMMING HATS.</p> <p>Homework will include spellings, times tables and daily reading.</p> <p>WINTER SHOW REHEARSALS WILL BE TAKING PLACE THIS WEEK.</p>
Year 5	<p>Trips: Thank you to all children and parents that came and supported us this week. We thoroughly enjoyed both trips!</p> <p>Maths: We will be exploring the four operations and strategies to solve problems related to each.</p> <p>English: We will look at constructing effective sentences.</p> <p>Topic/DT: We will investigate one of our local landmarks – Alexandra Palace. We will be creating and building local landmarks from boxes.</p> <p>PE: Monday and Tuesday - all children need to bring their PE kits every week. <u>Some children are still not bringing an appropriate change of kit for these lessons. Please ensure that PE kit is provided. This is a health and safety requirement.</u></p> <p>Swimming: Every other Tuesday – the teachers will inform the children when to bring their swimming kits – 13th December – 5 Warhol.</p> <p>Homework / Spelling: <u>To be handed out on Friday and needs to be returned on the following Friday.</u> Please encourage your child to complete homework and hand it in on time. Reading daily with your child and discussing the text will aid their progress in all subjects.</p>
Year 6	<p>Maths – We will be using co-ordinates to describe position in two and four quadrants.</p> <p>English – We will continue to explore Recounts and how we can use our 'Tool kit' to write effective diary entries of our own.</p> <p>Science/DT - We will be completing our activities on creating Structures and finding ways to test their strength and durability.</p> <p>Topic – Our Viking topic is still on going as we explore Viking life.</p> <p>PE - Please note that PE for year six has been reinstated on Fridays. Please can you ensure that your child has the appropriate Kit. Swimming will take place on Wednesdays as usual. Thank you for your support.</p>
