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NEXT WEEK ACTIVITIES FOR CAMPSBOURNE!

Week Beginning: 21/11/16

Nursery	Next week we will be reading Go Away Big Green Monster by torch light in our dark den. We will also be making our own version of the book A Dark, Dark Tale by finishing the story and imagining what's in the box at the end. We will learn a really fun dance to go with the song This Little Light of Mine and make Mr Men shadow puppets to play with in our shadow puppet theatre.
Reception	Next week we will be focusing on the story of 'Elmer'. We will be creating our own elephant masks and on writing day we will be writing instructions on how we made them. In maths we will be consolidating what is one more than/less than a given number and counting within 10. Wednesday is our cooking day if you would like to volunteer and help out, please talk to the class teacher. Lines have been given out for the Christmas show, we would really appreciate it if you could help your child learn these lines during your spare time, thank you! Please make sure your child brings in their book bag every day, so their book can be changed. Have a lovely weekend!
Year 1	<p>Literacy – We will be reading the story of Hannukah and discussing the people involved, setting and main events. Children will be orally retelling the story using storyboards and then writing sentences for the beginning, middle and end.</p> <p>Maths – Numbers to 20: The children will be counting numbers beyond ten, use place value to recognise numbers up to 20 and compare numbers to 20.</p> <p>Topic – We will begin to learn about the Jewish festival Hannukah. We will also be discussing places we have visited and climates around the world.</p> <p>Show & Tell – Show and Tell sessions will be held on the last Friday of each month (we will remind the children in class). This is a time when the children can bring in a special object, photo, book or a picture or model that they have created at home, to share with the class if they wish. Please remind your child not to bring toys into school. Thank you for your support.</p>
Year 2	<p>Maths: We will be starting a new unit of work on multiplication and division. The children will be using objects and pictures to support them in understanding multiplication as repeated addition and division as sharing and grouping.</p> <p>Literacy: The children will be planning and beginning to write their own Creation Stories.</p> <p>Science: We will be continuing to think about habitats and food chains.</p> <p>History: Using their knowledge of events during The Gunpowder Plot, the children will be creating a Wanted Poster for Thomas Percy.</p> <p>*P.E. will be reverting back to the original days of Tuesday and Wednesday. Library time will return to Mondays.*</p>
Year 3	<p>Next week, children will be undertaking assessments in Maths, Reading and Writing (ongoing within Literacy unit). We wish them the very best of luck!</p> <p>Maths: Children will continue to practise adding and subtracting 3-digit numbers using the column method (with regrouping).</p> <p>Literacy: Children will continue to innovate the story of 'Lazy Jack' and complete their altered version of it.</p> <p>Science: Next week, children will be understanding how mirrors work to reflect light.</p> <p>Topic: Children will be learning about Celtic weapons.</p> <p>PE: Please ensure children bring their PE kits weekly on Wednesdays and swimming kits fortnightly on Fridays. Please support your children with regular reading, spellings and times table practice.</p>
Year 4	<p>English – We will be continuing to innovate and improve ideas for our tales of revenge.</p> <p>Maths – We will be completing maths investigations and beginning our new module on discrete continuous data.</p> <p>Topic – We will be drawing and designing our Greek inspired pottery.</p> <p>Science – We will conducting an invertebrate hunt.</p> <p>P.E. - Both Picasso and Sekoto need to bring in their P.E kits on Friday.</p> <p>Swimming - Classes will swim on alternate Mondays, Sekoto will be swimming this Monday due to unforeseen cancellation in previous week. PLEASE REMEMBER SWIMMING HATS.</p> <p>Homework will include spellings, times tables and daily reading.</p> <p>THERE WILL BE NO TRUMPETS FOR PICASSO THURSDAY 24TH NOVEMBER 2016</p>
Year 5	<p>Next week is assessment week. Assessments will take place throughout the week in English and Maths. Please ensure that your children have a hearty breakfast and get good night's rest before school. We are extremely confident that all children in Year 5 will do very well!</p> <p>Maths: We will be converting between units of time (12- and 24-hour clocks) to solve problems.</p> <p>English: We will be gradually creating our own version of 'The Ants and the Grasshopper' fable story by gathering and sharing ideas.</p> <p>Topic: We will start a new topic on our local area. The children will discuss what they know and what they would like to find out.</p> <p>Science: We will start phase one of our experiment; we will plant seeds and observe their growth.</p> <p>PE: Monday and Tuesday - all children need to bring their PE kits every week. <u>Some children are still not bringing an appropriate change of kit for these lessons. Please ensure that PE kit is provided. This is a health and safety requirement.</u></p> <p>Swimming: Every other Tuesday – the teachers will inform the children when to bring their swimming kits – 22nd November – 5 Lowry.</p> <p>Homework / Spelling: <u>To be handed out on Friday and needs to be returned on the following Friday.</u> Please encourage your child to complete homework and hand it in on time. Reading daily with your child and discussing the text will aid their progress in all subjects.</p>
Year 6	<p>Maths - Use negative numbers in context, and calculate intervals across zero, understand the order of operations and use the BODMAS rule to carry out calculations involving the four operations and brackets.</p> <p>English - We are continuing to explore suspense writing and create pieces of our own which includes specific skills for tension building including use of short sentences, complex sentences and inference to show emotions.</p> <p>Science - We will be studying fossils, their formation and their influence on our knowledge of animals and evolution.</p> <p>Topic - We are continuing to study The Vikings and explore who King Ethelred II was and understand when and why Danegeld was introduced.</p> <p>PE - Please note that PE for year six has been reinstated on Fridays. Please can you ensure that your child has the appropriate kit? Swimming will take place on Wednesdays as usual. Thank you for your support.</p>
