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# NEXT WEEK ACTIVITIES FOR CAMPSBOURNE!

## Week Beginning: 19/10/15

<b>Reception</b>	<p>Next week we will be focusing on what job we would like to have when we grow up and on writing day we will be writing about it. We will also be looking at non-fiction books and comparing them to fiction books. We will be using one of our senses 'touch' to describe how different objects feel. In maths we will be consolidating what we have learnt. This half term, focusing on number formation, repeated patterns and properties of 2D shapes. We are creating a garden in our outside area and it would be really appreciated if you could donate any spare seeds, bulbs or compost that you have at home for us to use. Please remember it is parents evening next Monday the 19th and Wednesday the 21st, so please sign up to a time slot if you have not done so already. There is also a cheese and wine evening in the dinner hut on Wednesday the 21st for new parents to go along to. Hope you have a lovely weekend, the reception team!</p>
<b>Year 1</b>	<p><b>English:</b> This week we will use maps to describe what we can see on our journeys to school. We will focus on using interesting descriptive language, as well as positional/directional and time related vocabulary (e.g. first, next, then, after).</p> <p><b>Maths:</b> We will be making fact families within 10. We are going to be using addition and subtraction within word problems and doing a maths quiz.</p> <p><b>RE:</b> We will begin to know about harvest and food.</p> <p><b>Science:</b> We are learning to know what humans need to keep themselves healthy.</p> <p><b>Geography:</b> We will be discussing our journey to school and 'landmarks' that we see on our journey.</p> <p><b>PSHE:</b> We are describing what a good friend is.</p>
<b>Year 2</b>	<p>Julie's Language and Literacy group will be exploring poetic techniques, e.g. rhyme, rhythm, repetition and alliteration. RML will continue. In Maths Mastery we will begin to look at addition and subtraction word problems. In Science we will be doing a mid-topic assessment to see what the children have learnt about habitats. History/PSHE/Art - we will putting the individual patches from 2 O'Keefe and 2 Seurat together to make our patch work quilt for Black History Month. Don't forget book bags every day, particularly Wednesday and Thursday. Children need their P.E kits for P.E on Tuesday and Wednesday.</p>
<b>Year 3</b>	<p><b>Maths:</b> Measurement – This week the children will be learning about mass. They will be reading scales (in kg and g), comparing masses and adding and subtracting mass.</p> <p><b>English:</b> The children will continue to look at play scripts and will have a go at writing their own.</p> <p><b>Science:</b> This week we will be learning about muscles.</p> <p><b>Topic:</b> We will be learning about Stonehenge. We will be thinking about why it was built, what it looks like and why it is famous.</p> <p><b>PE:</b> Please ensure your child has their PE kit in school on a Wednesdays/Thursdays.</p> <p><b>Parent's Evening</b> (Monday 19<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> October): Please sign up for an appointment with your child's teacher, to discuss how they have settled in to Year 3.</p>
<b>Year 4</b>	<p><b>Maths:</b> We will working on worded problems and deciding on appropriate calculations to solve them.</p> <p><b>English:</b> We will be writing and editing information texts using paragraphs with appropriate headings.</p> <p><b>Science:</b> We will be learning how to formulate 'keys' to identify living things.</p> <p><b>PE:</b> Tuesday and Friday (Sekoto class), Thursday and Friday (Picasso class). These will be alternate sessions of PE and swimming but this is subject to change so all children need to bring both swimming and PE kits each week.</p> <p><b>Harvest:</b> We will appreciate any donations from Monday, of tins or packets of food, for our assembly on Wednesday</p> <p><b>Homework:</b> Homework will be given out on Fridays. Please encourage your child to complete homework and return it on Wednesdays. Reading daily with your child and discussing the text will aid their progress in all subjects. Handwriting and times tables also need to be practised for short bursts each day.</p>
<b>Year 5</b>	<p><b>Maths:</b> We will be exploring properties of 3D shapes.</p> <p><b>English:</b> We will be learning how a reporter's description of an event might not always be reliable.</p> <p><b>Science:</b> We will be investigating the effect that different substances have on materials.</p> <p><b>Topic:</b> We will be designing Anglo Saxon shields.</p> <p><b>PE:</b> Monday and Tuesday. On Monday, the children require both their swimming and PE kits. On Tuesday, the children just need their PE kits.</p> <p><b>Homework:</b> Will be given on Monday, to be handed in on Friday.</p> <p><b>Parent Consultations:</b> We look forward to meeting you all!</p>
<b>Year 6</b>	<p><b>Maths:</b> adding and subtracting fractions.</p> <p><b>English:</b> studying poetry with a focus on personification.</p> <p><b>Topic:</b> exploring California's industries.</p> <p><b>Science:</b> recreating the timeline of evolution.</p> <p><b>PE/Swimming</b> will take place on a Friday afternoon. Please ensure your child brings the appropriate kit.</p> <p><b>Quick reminder:</b> parent consultations Monday and Wednesday!</p>
