Dear Parents and Carers,

We have had some exciting visitors in during the week. The sailing team from Greig City Academy gave a very inspirational talk about their achievements to Key Stage 2. We also had visitors from the fire brigade service explaining all about fire safety. Finally Mr Jonathan Smith, (our new head teacher from January), visited all the classrooms on Wednesday to introduce himself to the children.

Next week is assessment week. The assessments the children will be taking help us not only monitor their progress, but help teachers plan next steps. As the old system of "levels" has gone, we are using assessments which also give us a standardised score. In these tests, the average standard age score for any age group is always 100: this makes it easy to tell whether a pupil is above or below the national average. It's going to be a wintery weekend and from now on the temperature will be much colder. Please remember that it is essential your child comes to school wearing a warm, showerproof coat, even if they are dropped off by car. Thank you!

NEXT WEEK ACTIVITIES FOR CAMPSBOURNE!

Week Beginning: 23/11/15

Reception	<p>Next week we are focusing on the story of 'Elmer the Elephant'. We will be making our very own elephant masks and on writing day we will be writing instructions on how we made them. In maths we will be estimating and adding two groups together to find the total. If you have any spare clothes, underwear, tights, socks etc.. that you wouldn't mind donating to the lower school this would be much appreciated! Hope you have a lovely weekend, from the reception team.</p>
Year 1	<p>Literacy – We will be writing a description about a setting. Maths – We will be assessing the children and continuing with our number patterns within 20. RE – We will be understanding the importance of the Menorah during the festival of Hanukkah. Science – Outdoor learning. The children will be outside observing and describing different types of cloud formation. Show & Tell – <i>Show and Tell sessions will be held on the last Friday of each month (we will remind the children in class). This is a time when the children can bring in a special object, photo, book or a picture or model that they have created at home, to share with the class if they wish. Please remind your child not to bring toys into school. Thank you for your support.</i></p>
Year 2	<p>Julie's Language and Literacy group will be using a non-fiction text to identify how non chronological texts are structured to help the reader find information. Christina's Literacy and Language group will be beginning to explore characters in depth, ready to use them in their stories. In Maths Mastery we will start to look at different types of graphs. In Science we will be revisiting habitats around the school to see how they have changed. In Geography we will be going around the world on a piece of string. In Computing children will start coding using Espresso. In Art children will be making posters for the Road Safety competition. Don't forget book bags every day, particularly Wednesday and Thursday and children need their P.E kits for P.E on Tuesday and Wednesday.</p>
Year 3	<p>Maths: Children will be focusing on 4 digit numbers and adding/subtracting thousands. Literacy: Children will begin investigating the features of 'Discussion Texts'. Art: In Art, we will be looking at a variety of landscape artists and their work. The children will then create their very own! Topic: We will learn about compass directions and map symbols. PE: Please ensure your child has their PE kit in school on Wednesdays/Thursdays. ***REMINDER: Year 3 will commence rehearsals for the Christmas Show next week. Please ensure your child brings in the following: Monet : plain green t-shirt/jumper and dark trousers/leggings Kandinsky: green, white, red or Christmas jumper/t-shirt and dark leggings/trousers</p>
Year 4	<p>Maths: This week we will be working with multiplication and division word problems. English: We will be writing and editing stories with a dilemma. Topic: Our topic on Ancient Greece will be Ancient Greek Democracy. PE: Thursdays and Fridays for BOTH Classes. Please ensure your child has an appropriate change of kit for these lessons. This is a health and safety requirement. Music: Please ensure that instruments are brought to school for these lessons and that your child practises at home. Homework: Homework will be given out on Fridays. Please encourage your child to complete homework and return it on Wednesdays. Reading daily with your child and discussing the text will aid their progress in all subjects. Handwriting and times tables also need to be practised for short bursts each day.</p>
Year 5	<p>Maths: We will be recognising and using square numbers and cube numbers. English: We will be developing awareness of the narrative voice in a text. Science: We will be exploring the size of the planets in our Solar System. Topic: We will be designing an information book about Alexandra Palace. PE: Monday and Tuesday. On Monday, the children require both their swimming and PE kits. On Tuesday, the children just need their PE kits. Homework: Will be given on Monday, to be handed in on Friday. Trip: Apologies about the cancellation of our trip to Kenwood House. We will endeavour to go on an alternative trip in the near future.</p>
Year 6	<p>Maths - converting between standard units of length to solve problems. English - write a non-chronological report about beavers. Topic - identify and explain key aspects of Viking life. Science - continue studying evolution and inheritance. PE/Swimming will take place on a Friday afternoon. Please ensure your child brings the appropriate kit.</p>
