

# Campsbourne Primary School

## ***Sports Premium***

PE and Sport play an important part in the life at Campsbourne Primary School with at least two hours per week dedicated to physical activity in the curriculum including swimming for years four, five and six. We believe that physical education and sport contribute significantly to the development of young people and that through the participation in sport and physical education, young people learn more about important values such as teamwork, fair play and respect for themselves and others.

There is significant evidence to show the positive effects of sport and exercise on children's physical health, growth and development. Furthermore, sport also provides a healthy environment for young people to learn how to deal with competition and to cope with challenge.

In April 2013, the Government announced new funding (Sport Premium) for Physical Education (PE) and sport to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision at school. Possible uses for the funding might include:

- Hiring specialist PE teachers or qualified sports coaches to work with primary teachers when teaching PE.
- Supporting and engaging the least active children through new or additional Change4Life clubs.
- Paying for professional development opportunities for teachers in PE and sport.
- Running sport competitions, or increasing pupils' participation in the School Games.
- Enhance the playtime experience by making playtimes and lunchtimes more active.

Each school will have received £8000 plus an additional £5 per pupil for the next two years- for Campsbourne Primary School this meant we should receive £17,620 for the 2016 / 2017 academic year.

## ***How are we planning to spend the Sports Premium at Campsbourne 2017 – 2018***

We are using the Primary Schools' Sports Premium to further enhance our provision by increasing capacity to deliver high quality PE lessons in the school. This has been achieved by employing a specialist PE instructor on to our full time staff who provides high quality PE lessons every week for your child but also professional development opportunities for other teaching staff.

We are investing £2000 to release the PE instructor to attend high quality professional development which will then be disseminated to all teaching staff increasing our capacity to provide high quality PE.

This professional development will include whole school staff meetings as well as working with teachers from different year groups throughout the year planning together, observing best practice and team teaching.

## ***Swimming***

The school has its own swimming pool which means we are able to provide swimming lessons for years 3 to 6 which is more than the statutory requirement. We employ a swimming instructor for 5 afternoons a week and set targets in excess of the national curriculum.

### ***Playtimes and Lunchtimes***

We are investing £8000 in a sports coach to run physical activities during lunch time and upskill our SMSAs so that they can disseminate the activities into our other playgrounds to ensure that children are as active as possible during playtimes and lunchtimes.

We are investing £5000 in two concrete tables tennis tables to provide children with opportunities to develop hand eye coordination.
