Access to the Infant Playground



I know that parents enjoy staying behind after school to catch up and allowing their children to play in the infant playground. However, I am afraid that it will no longer be possible for the children to use the climbing frame and tree houses in the infant playground. This playground has been designed to provide children with more challenge than you would find in a normal public park. We have been able to create this space because we are a school with staff who supervise the children when using it. This means when the relevant health and safety body inspect it they take into account that it is being supervised by staff unlike a public park. If it was treated as a public park it would not pass the inspection.

We can therefore not allow children to use this unless they are being supervised by staff. Should an accident occur the school would be breaching its duty of care as children would not have been appropriately supervised. We are currently looking at training staff so that this space can be hired out at the weekends for birthday parties.
