The children will learn to imitate the text, innovate on it and finally create their own recount using the specific writing skills they have learnt from this unit.

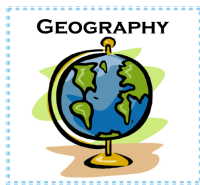
Maths

This term we will be focusing on:

- Shapes and space
- Number problems
- Algebra
- Problem solving
- Targeted SATS revision and preparation

History & Geography

In **Topic** we will be studying our local area. In particular, focusing on Alexandra Palace—a major landmark in the locality that is being renovated.



Computing

In **Computing** we will be studying key computational thinkers and how the impact that they have made towards technology. The children will be examining a variety of devices and addressing the impact that they are having on society.



RE

Our focus this half term is **Christianity and Buddhism.**

We will begin by discussing the effect of religion on the life of an individual. We will investigate the key aspects of both of these religions.

A key question that we will continue to examine will be:
