### Hello Everyone

#### IMPORTANT: New Improvements to Communicating Accidents with Parents

We have recently introduced a new system called Medical Tracker which we will use to record and track all medical concerns / accidents. We have introduced this system to improve recording of incidents and communication with parents / carers when your child is involved in an accident. After half term if your child is involved in an accident, which is not an emergency but requires some basic first aid you will receive a text or an email to inform you. This will replace the paper slip, which you should currently receive but often find it gets lost!

**You do not need to contact the school when you receive a text or email. If it is an emergency or your child needs to be collected we will continue to contact you by phone.**



### Health and Safety Week

The first week back after half term is Health and Safety Week. Children will take part in workshops throughout the week to learn about basic first aid. Children in Reception, Year 1 and 2 will learn about:

- The body and its functions; assessment of consciousness and breathing
- Wound treatment, bleeding
- Unconsciousness, open airway and recovery position
- Behaviour in emergency situations; emergency call

Repetition and first aid scenarios

Children in years 3 to 6 will learn about

- Behaviour in emergency situations; emergency call
- DR ABC
- Recovery Position
- Wound treatment, bleeding
- Choking
- CPR/Hands Only CPR



On Tuesday 5<sup>th</sup> June children will also enjoy workshops which challenge and stretch themselves beyond their existing knowledge and experience of healthy living as they solve problems, answer thought provoking questions and complete progressively more difficult tasks. Activities are stimulating and engaging with the key messages of looking after our bodies and keeping healthy infiltrating our whole programme. Topics include: the human body, healthy eating, balanced diet, nutritional values, importance of physical activity, teeth, hygiene, sleep, household safety, alcohol & drugs (yr5/6 only) and making informed choices. 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### Parent 1<sup>st</sup> Aid Workshop

As parents, grandparents, guardians and carers of young children, safety is an important issue. 80% of first aid incidents happen in the home, accidents do happen and sometimes a plaster is not enough. This 1 Hour First Aid for Parents Workshop provides you with the opportunity to gain the skills that could save a child's life. Skills include:  
Incident Management (DR ABC)  
Basic Life Support (child and baby)  
Recovery Position  
Action for Choking
