Physical Development

- Continue to develop fine and gross motor skills indoors and out.

Literacy

- Core books: Handa's Surprise/ Mr Gumpy's outing/ Who sank the boat /Billy Bean/ The Train Ride/ Mrs Armitage/ Wild Things
- Phonics: Letters And Sounds Programme: Oral blending and segmenting. Linking letters to sounds.

Maths

- Recognise some numerals of personal significance.
- Counts objects to 10, and beginning to count beyond 10.
- Beginning to talk about the shapes of everyday objects, e.g. '*round*' and '*tall*'.
- Selects a particular named shape.
- Orders two or three items by length or height.

Communication and Language

Opportunities to talk about family/home life & our communities and journeys we have made. Reflecting on our year in Nursery.

Understanding the World

- Experiments with water: Floating and sinking/ displacement/ dissolving etc
