English

The children will learn to read parts with expression and interpret characters moods and actions.

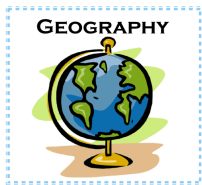
Maths

This term we will be focusing on Life skills needed to work successfully with money in the adult world. The children will be:

- Exploring money management
- Exploring the meaning of some Money-related vocabulary
- Learning to read and work with bank statements and other financial documents

History & Geography

In **History** we will be completing our topic of study - exploring the art, culture, and scientific advancements of 'early Islamic Civilisations'.



Computing

In **Computing** we will be developing resources to aid their move to Secondary School, including designing a multimedia presentation introducing them to their new school and classmates.



PSHE

Year 6 will be learning about the importance of safe and healthy relationships amongst each other. The children will be taught about how bodies change during adolescence.

of how movement is portrayed in
art, and these techniques in our
own art work.

We will also develop group work with

skills.
