Dear Parent / Carers,

We have had a brilliant start to the new school year. We had 3 days of excellent staff training including a morning on unconscious bias and how we can adapt our practice to ensure we remove bias as much as possible. The staff also worked incredibly hard during these three days to prepare the school whilst also negotiating the army of builders who were also on site ensuring we could open on time. I would like to thank everyone who has helped the start of the school year to be so smooth.

The children have been amazing and have adapted to having builders and all their equipment on site very sensibly. The scaffolding around the gym will be up for about 4 weeks as they repair the roof of the gym. The completion of the heating system and electrical works will be carried out after school so that disruption is kept to an absolute minimum. We will continue with using the 3 entrances until the middle playground is back in use which should be after half term.

After School Club

Due to building works taking place after school we have to move the after school club from the infant building to the dining hall. This means all pickups will take place from the main entrance on Nightingale Lane.
