Ultra-Low Emission Zone (ULEZ)

The beginning of half term will see the expansion of the Ultra-Low Emission Zone (ULEZ), a scheme by the Mayor of London and TFL to reduce air pollution in London. Did you know that exposure to high levels of nitrogen dioxide (NO2) pollution can cause and exacerbate asthma, wheezing and other lung conditions - and introducing the ULEZ in Central London resulted in a reduction of NO2 by 44%? From October 25th, driving within or into the ULEZ zone (which will cover the area between the North and South circulars) with a non-compliant car will incur a charge.
