#### 8.1 To Agree

The Committee received and noted the policies list below which were circulated in advance of this meeting.

# Extended Schools Policy (Do we want to increase fees)

A Governor raised a question relating to page 3 (fees table) Is the 50% discount extended to families who may be struggling but not eligible for in-work benefits? Appreciate that this may be discretionary and therefore not appropriate to include in the policy. The HT said yes the school uses its discretion and does extend discount to other families when needed.

The Chair asked how is this funded, the HT responded the children go to the after-school club.

A Governor raised a question relating to page top of p.4 "Places for families who the school has identified as having particularly high needs." Is there a link to a description of such needs? The HT responded that would not be fair to have as the school never knows what the circumstances are, and no one falls into one criterion. Children come at differing times so school has to make a judgement and to date have not had to say no to anyone. The Chair said if anything changes to let the committee know.

A Governor asked when the fees were last increased, the HT said a few years ago, at present is bringing in income but this item needs to be kept under regular review.

The HT said he will ask Diane how many people get the 50% discount. **Action HT.** Extended school clubs discount and costs item for next agenda. **Action HT, Clerk.** 

A Governor said her understanding from her link visit with Wendy was that due to high demand Breakfast Club places are allocated primarily to children with working parents with just a couple held back for children with high needs. Is this also discretionary, or should it be reflected in the policy? The HT said the school uses its discretion.
