### **Our new topic is Traditional Tales**

#### **Personal, Social and Emotional Development**

Using traditional tales to initiate talk about doing the right thing.  
Continue to use our interactive Zones of Regulation display.

#### **Communication and Language**

Sequencing and creating stories (Tales Toolkit). Describing our teddy bears.

#### **Physical Development**

Continue to develop fine and gross motor skills indoors and out.

#### **Literacy**

Core books: Jack and the Beanstalk, Goldilocks, The Three Little Pigs, The Three Billy Goats Gruff, The Gingerbread Man, Little Red Riding Hood

Phonics: Daily activities/building on opportunities in continuous provision and specific teaching of blending and segmenting CVC words, phonemes, syllables, rhyme and alliteration.

#### **Maths**

Know that the last number reached when counting a small set of objects tells you how many there are in total.

Experiments with capacity. (Which holds more/less)

Describe a familiar route.

Discuss routes and locations, using words like 'in front of' and 'behind'.

Positional language- in, on, under etc.

#### **Understanding the World**

Sowing seeds and learning what plants need to grow. Learning about farm animals and their babies.

Observing the signs of Spring.

**Expressive Art and Design:** Observational paintings of our bears. Acting out the traditional stories.

**Forest School will be taking place every Tuesday morning and Friday afternoon, so please ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for the weather on that day.**
