



Dear year 3 parents and carers,

Welcome to year 3!

We have had a lovely time settling in with the children and have been really impressed with them. They have shown such a positive attitude to their learning and all seem so happy to be back at school. We have outlined our curriculum plan for the first half of the autumn term below:

Reading

Within our *Destination Reader* lessons this term, we will be learning to use different reading strategies. These include clarifying, inferring, making connections, evaluating, summarising and asking questions about a variety of texts. This half term we will start by reading: *Stone Age Boy*, *Stone Age Bone Age* and *Stone Age News*. The children in year 3 also follow our *Accelerated Reader* programme. They will take quizzes on the books that they have read at school.

Writing

This half term we are learning how to write a warning tale, based on the model text *Nail Soup*. The children will be focusing on the structural and language features of a warning tale. They will be developing their ability to describe characters and will be learning how to write and punctuate direct speech within a story.

Maths

During this half term we are exploring place value and number sense with numbers up to 1000. We will then move on to a unit on addition and subtraction, during which the children will develop their understanding and use of the column method. We will be practising our 2, 3, 5, 8- and 10-times tables throughout.

History

For the autumn term we will be exploring the *Stone Age to the Iron Age*. The children will learn about humans who lived during these times, their way of life and then also compare this period of history with Ancient Egypt.

Religious Education

In year 3 we learn about Christianity and Sikhism. This half term the children will be learning all about Sikhism and the Khalsa, as well as exploring the significance of the 5Ks.

Physical Education

Our PE this half term is a Games unit. The children will be focusing on *Invasion Games* and developing the skills of passing, receiving and travelling with the ball. Additionally, the curriculum will incorporate elements related to general fitness activities to promote overall physical well-being. Hockney class will have swimming lessons on Thursdays this half term. Cameron will have swimming lessons on Thursdays after the October half term.

PSHE

In PSHE we are looking at *Rights, Rules and Responsibilities* within our school and the wider community. We will also be holding our school council elections.

Science

We will begin the year by finding out about the human body. The children will be learning about the skeleton, muscles and joints and their role in how we move our bodies. They will then be thinking about nutrition and diet

Art

The children will be finding out about our year group artists (David Hockney and Julia Margaret Cameron) and using their work as inspiration for their own art.

Music

In music sessions with Jeannie, the children will be introduced to samba music.

Computing

Our focus for computing this half term is *Connecting Computers*. The children will develop their understanding of digital devices, with an initial focus on inputs, processes, and outputs. They will also compare digital and non-digital devices.

Spanish

In Key Stage 2 the children learn Spanish. We will be following the *Language Magnet* programme of study. This term the children will learn greetings, numbers, colours and countries.

Library

Each class have regular library sessions. This is an opportunity for the children to spend some time browsing the books and swapping their reading book. Hockney's library session is on Mondays, whilst Cameron class will go on Fridays.

Homework

Homework letters will be sent home each week on a Friday. We are focusing on spelling and multiplication and division facts. Spelling challenge takes place on a Friday. Please encourage your child to practise their spellings daily. Please support your child by discussing the homework tasks with them and if you are unsure please do not hesitate to contact your child's teacher.

Introduction to year 3 meeting

An introductory meeting will take place on Monday 16th September at 3.45pm. This will take place in 3 **Hockney**. During this meeting we will give you an overview of the routines and curriculum that we will be exploring in year 3.
