Progress and Attainment of Learner at Campsbourne Summer 2025

In the summer term each year, children in Year 6 undertake statutory assessments. They sit the Standards Assessment Tests (SATs) papers in Reading, Mathematics, and Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling (GPS). Writing is assessed by teachers using evidence collected throughout the year. These assessments are administered in all primary schools across the country in order to measure the attainment and progress of learners, and to help Ofsted and prospective parents make judgements about the effectiveness of the school.
